

# 21st Dubai Open Chess Tournament 2019

Sheikh Rashed bin Hamdan AL Maktoum Cup 31<sup>st</sup> March - 11<sup>th</sup> April 2019 USD 50,000 Prize Fund

Under the Patronage of **Sheikh Rashid Bin Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum**, Dubai Chess & Culture Club is pleased to announce the **21**<sup>st</sup> **Dubai Open Chess Tournament 2019**, which will be held at Dubai Chess & Culture Club from **31**<sup>st</sup> **March** - **11**<sup>th</sup> **April 2019**.

#### 1. Participants & Registration:

- 1.1. Open to all FIDE-rated players with a **Standard (std.)** rating of **1500 and above** (as of February 1, 2019).
- 1.2. Last day of registration & payment is March 5, 2019.
- 1.3. Registration is only accepted online via the following link
- 1.4. All participating players and accompany persons accepts to fully comply with the rules and regulations of the tournament, the organizer & the United Arab Emirates.
- 1.5. Organizing committee reserves the right to accept or deny a participant's registration according to FIDE Rules and regulations and UAE Laws.

#### 2. Number of Rounds & Time Control:

- 2.1. Nine Rounds Swiss System.
- 2.2. **Time Control:** 90 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move for the whole game.
- 2.3. **Delay Time:** 30-minute delay will apply.

3.1. At **Dubai Chess & Culture Club** (*Sheikh Saeed Bin Hamdan Al Maktoum Hall*), AlMamzar - Dubai, United Arab Emirates. **How to get there?**

- 5.6. Absent Winners Prizes will be cancelled
- 5.7. Prizewinners are requested to follow the dress code of business casual / elegant casual or smart casual. No shorts, sports shoes, sneakers, slippers, hats or caps.

- 1. Direct encounter.
- 2. Buchholz (lowest).
- 3. Buchholz (highest + lowest).
- 4. Great Number of victories.

#### 7. Accommodation Condition:

- 7.1. **Grandmasters** with a standard Elo of **2600** + and **Women Grandmasters** with a standard Elo of **2300** + may <u>apply</u> for Free accommodation in the Tournament's official Hotel by submitting the following <u>form</u>.
- 7.2. Last day of accepting Accommodation Condition applicants is January 15, 2019.
- 7.3. The organizer will accept a <u>limited</u> number of Accommodation Condition applicants.
- 7.4. Applying for accommodation does not automatically make the player eligible to get a condition.
- 7.5. If a participant's application for accommodation condition was accepted, the organizer will contact the player directly with an <u>official form to be signed and returned</u> as instructed through the email.

## 8. Visa:

- 8.1. Please check the requirements of visa via the following link
- 8.2. Visa rules are subject to change. Kindly confirm with your airline prior booking.
- 8.3. Players / accompany persons who require a visa are requested to upload and attach a <u>clear scanned colored copy</u> of their passports and scanned colored personal photo (both in JPEG Format) in the online application form.
  - 8.3.1. For Indian citizens, last page of the passport is required for visa.
  - 8.3.2. For Syrian citizens, "Issue/Expiry page" of the passport is required for visa.
  - 8.3.3. For Bangladeshi citizens, "Information of the Bearer page of the passport is required for visa.
- 8.4. Minor accompany persons applying via Dubai Chess Club require a separate passport to process an entry visa.
- 8.5. Entry visas to the UAE issued for eligible participants **subject to the approval** of the **General Directorate of Residency & Foreigner Affairs UAE** and will be valid for 30 days from the date of arrival.
- 8.6. All Visa application fees are non-refundable
